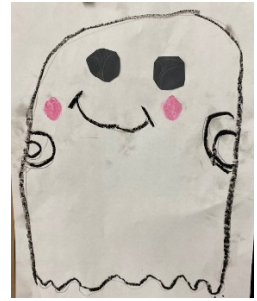


LYNDHURST OCTOBER 2021 NEWSLETTER
