Attendance

Regular attendance is an essential part of determining student success at school. It is important that our students come to school on time and that their attendance is consistent. In doing so, they can become an active part of the classroom learning community. This in turn causes less anxiety and students will be much more comfortable interacting with their classmates.

Supervision

A reminder to families that there is no supervision for students before 8:50am and after 3:00pm unless students are in school programs (i.e. clubs, sports, etc.)

Late Arrivals

If your child arrives late, please have them sign in at the office before going to their classroom. This ensures that the school office is aware of our students' attendance.

Tips on Arriving on Time:

- · Pack backpacks in the evening
- · Have your child get to bed at a reasonable time so they will have an easier time waking up in the morning
- · Have your child set an alarm in their own room

Leaving During the Day

If a student is leaving during the day or for the afternoon, they are asked to check out at the office. Also, the school or teacher must be notified by the parent that the student will be absent. Students will not be permitted to leave the school grounds during the school day without parental consent.

Important Safety Reminders

Student safety is one of our top priorities. Parents should not be entering the staff parking lot to drop off or pick up students.

PLEASE NOTE – We are working with the City of Burnaby to ensure that the parking signage around Lyndhurst allows access to Lyndhurst and is accessible for the needs of our school community.

All students will be enjoying the outdoors for 15 minutes at recess and approximately 40 minutes during the lunch hour. Our outdoor time is called a "West Coast Recess and Lunch". Please ensure that your child is prepared with appropriate clothing for the weather outside throughout the school year. It is recommended that students also keep a change of clothes at school in case it is needed.
